**JAMES JESSE, DDS**

Dr. James Jesse graduated from Loma Linda University in 1973. He has been in private practice in Colton, California for the past 31 years. In addition to lecturing nationally and internationally, Dr. Jesse is an associate Professor at Loma Linda and an assistant Professor at Columbia University. Dr. Jesse also does Forensic Dentistry in San Diego County and is a Deputy Sheriff with San Bernardino County.
